SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

THERAPY ADMINISTRATION

Saphnelo (Anifrolumab-fnia) 300mg in 100ml 0.9% sodium chloride

- Dose: 300mg in 100ml NS
- Route: intravenous
- Frequency: once every 4 weeks
- Infuse over 30 minutes
- Flush with 0.9% sodium chloride at infusion completion

SAPHNELO (ANIFROLUMAB-FNIA)

- SAPHNELO is supplied as a single-dose, 2 mL vial containing 300 mg of anifrolumab-fnia.
- Do not shake the vial. Visually inspect the vial for particulate matter and discoloration. (SAPHNELO is a clear to opalescent and colorless to slightly yellow solution.)
- Withdraw and discard 2 mL of solution from a 50 mL or 100 mL 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection, USP infusion bag.
- Withdraw 2 mL from the SAPHNELO vial and add to the infusion bag.
- Mix the solution by gently inverting the bag. DO NOT SHAKE THE BAG. (Each vial is intended for single use only. Discard any concentrate remaining in the vial.)
- Administer the infusion solution IV over a 30-minute period through an infusion line containing a sterile, low-protein binding 0.2 to 15 micron in-line or add-on filter. [If a serious infusion-related or hypersensitivity reaction (eg, anaphylaxis) occurs, immediately interrupt the administration and initiate appropriate therapy]
- To ensure the complete dose of SAPHNELO has been administered, flush the entire infusion line with 25 mL of 0.9% Sodium Chloride Injection, USP at the end of the infusion.
